CCIS – Terms for Bulk Purchases of Conference Proceedings





Springer CCIS offers its conference and workshop proceedings as

- Online access to the content on SpringerLink
- Printed books
- USB sticks
- E-content licenses (navigable electronic content)

By default, CCIS proceedings are produced as e-books accessible to conference participants through an http referrer from the conference website for four weeks. Printed books, USBs (containing the electronic content of the respective printed proceedings) or navigable electronic content are only produced for conferences/symposia/workshops if organizers or volume editors have explicitly requested this.

USBs of CCIS proceedings are not kept in stock and are not available for purchase from the warehouse. The production time line for USBs is the same as for printed books.

Our USB proceedings or navigable electronic content include pdf full-text search functionality, author index and bibtex files. The minimum number of USBs or navigable electronic content that have to be purchased is 50.

► If you require any **USBs** or navigable electronic content, kindly make sure that we are informed when you upload the electronic manuscript to our server.

1. Prices for Bulk Purchases of Conference Proceedings

1.1. Prices for Books

Volume editors or conference organizers may buy copies of their proceedings at preferential rates (which reflect a discount of at least 50% off the list price). Prices depend on the number of pages and the number of copies purchased. Please see the table below for details.

All prices shown in this document are <u>net prices in Euro</u>.

The page ranges referred to are total page counts incl. all front- and back-matter pages.

1.2 Prices for USBs

We can also provide, for distribution at conferences and workshops, USB proceedings delivered as separate items.

These will be structured as follows:



The prices of USBs depend on the <u>total</u> number of text pages needed in the printed books as follows:

USBs are only offered if at least 50 USBs are purchased.

Please note that no discounts are applied to USB prices.

1.3 Navigable Electronic Content (e-content licenses)

In case you would like to produce your own USB sticks or CD-ROMs for distribution to the conference participants, you have the option of purchasing the navigable electronic content only. The net prices per item are as follows:

Navigable electronic content is only offered if at least 50 licenses are purchased. There is a minimum purchase of 50 e-licenses.

1.4 Prices for Multiple-Volume Book Sets

If the total number of pages in a proceedings volume exceeds 800 pages, then the content has to be split across two or more print volumes by the volume editors. Respecting natural break points, we aim to distribute pages equally among the volumes of a set.

The prices for print proceedings published in more than one CCIS volume are calculated by adding the individual bulk prices for the volumes needed. There are, however, additional discounts applied to the prices of the print proceedings sets:

2. Free Copies

2.1 Free Online Access

Please note that there are no royalties associated with editing CCIS volumes, however we offer registered conference participants temporary free access to the online version of the conference proceedings on SpringerLink (http://link.springer.com) by means of an http referrer from the conference website. This option replaces the option of getting 25 free printed books, as essentially, it allows any participant to download an electronic version of the proceedings e-book (either as complete pdf or as individual chapters). Access is granted for approximately four weeks, starting a few days before the meeting.

2.2 Free Printed Copies

As an alternative to the temporary free access, Volume Editors may opt to receive **25 complimentary printed copies**. These are only offered if the manuscript is sent to us **no later than 6 months after the conference**. If you would like to receive the **25** free printed copies, please inform us beforehand, otherwise the free online access will be used as the default option.

If at least 100 USBs are purchased, the volume editors may receive the 25 free copies as USBs.

The free copies can be given as e-content-licenses, if at least 50 are purchased.

Springer offers the Online Conference Service OCS to help PC chairs manage the submission and review process. All conferences whose proceedings have been accepted for publication in the CCIS series may now use OCS - with technical support - free of charge.

4. Shipping Costs

Please note that, besides the costs for the books and/or USBs, the transportation costs also have to be covered for both the purchased and the free copies.

If you need a shipping quote, then please send an email to ccis@springer.com, giving the delivery address as well as the number of pages (roughly) your proceedings will have and the number of copies you will require.

Post-conference proceedings, whose delivery is not tied to a schedule, can be sent from our warehouse directly to the recipients. The shipping costs are passed on to you. If you are interested in this option, kindly write to ccis@springer.com. You will be sent an Excel sheet to be completed with the names and addresses of the recipients. We require one single invoicing address for the books and the delivery costs.

5. Various

Please note that all prices are subject to (local) VAT. If the recipient (and the billing party) has a VAT number that exempts them from paying VAT, then please submit this information along with the billing party's address so that we can make the necessary provisions for the invoice.

If you anticipate that a proforma invoice or any other special paperwork will be necessary for the dispatch of the books, then please let us know well in advance.
